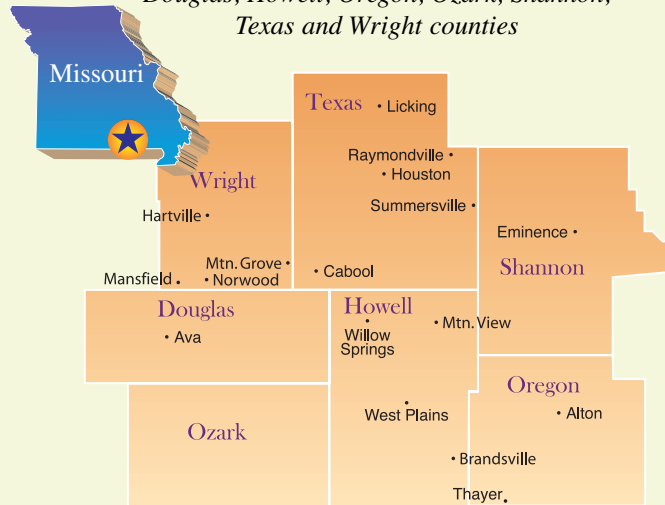
Is Home Health Care right for my loved one?

WESTWOOD HOME HEALTH

Westwood Home Health is a division of Willow Health Care, Inc., which is a non-profit corporation governed by

an unpaid Board of Directors whose purpose is to provide quality, cost effective health care to area residents.

What is homecare?

Home Health care consists of two distinct divisions. Although many local homecare agencies are not able to offer both types of home health, Westwood Home Health is ready to meet ALL of your homecare needs including:

Skilled Care At Home – When you have medical needs that require the expertise of licensed staff.

- Family is important. At Westwood Home Health we are a family and we would like to include you in our family of care. Our Registered Nurses, Home Health Aides, and Licensed Therapists are a part of our mission of caring for our community. You'll notice the difference as soon as they walk in the door. Westwood Home Health skilled care includes the following:
- Skilled Nursing Care – Health assessment, individualized treatment, and coordination of care from Registered Nurses following your physicians plan of care.
- Speech, Physical and Occupational Therapy – Individualized rehabilitation by licensed specialists to help you achieve maximum independence in your own home.
- Home Health Aide – Assistance with your activities of daily living from a trained aide under the supervision of a Registered Nurse.

Who pays for Skilled Care?

Generally, skilled care is paid by Medicare, your insurance company, or Medicaid with no cost to you. Westwood Home Health Staff will ensure payment from your insurance prior to initiating care.

In-Home Care – When you have non-medical needs and would like help with daily activities.

Your independence is not only important to you, it's important to us! Our goal at Westwood Home Health is to help you maintain your independence in the comfort and security of your own home. Westwood Home Health can provide you with:

In-Home aides – trained personal care attendants to help you with your activities of daily living including dressing, bathing, and meal preparation.

Homemaker aides – trained in-home aides who can assist you with activities such as; cleaning your home, meal preparation, laundry, shopping, and medication reminders.

Respite Care – trained in-home aides who come to provide relief for regular caregivers, which may include overnight care.

Skilled Nurse – A nurse may be provided to assist with activities such as medication set up, nail care, and general health assessment.

Who pays for In-Home Care?

Westwood Home Health is contracted with the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. Services may be paid for privately, but in most cases services are paid for through the MDHSS for qualified individuals.

How do I know if I qualify for services?

All it takes is a phone call to Westwood Home Health and we will be honored to assist you!
